Starting July 14th, you will be notified by email of events such as monthly statements and quarterly newsletters along with informational emails pertaining to your specific account. You will also be able to choose to receive certain emails about your account (example: When a certain check number clears your account.) You do not need to sign-up for this service as everyone with an email address on our system will be enrolled. If you would like to use a different email address from the one we currently have on file, you can change the email address via Net Access or by contacting us. You can confirm your current email address in Net Access under the "Your Preferences" tab.

There is a new link on our home page with information about the service, but if you have a question, you can always call our office and speak to one of our staff.

DISCLOSURE:

With this service you acknowledge that the credit union may use the email address you have provided to send you email. You may elect to receive or not/receive some types of email but you may automatically qualify for other types of email. The different types of email are noted on the "Access Accounts - e-Mail Notification" page in Net Access which will be available beginning July 14th.

You also acknowledge that email sent to you may include information about your account including, but not limited to, your name, email address, masked account number and check numbers. The credit union is not responsible for non-receipt of email notifications due to any reason.

PRIVACY

Your email address will not be shared with other companies or affiliated third parties without express permission from you.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I CHANGE MY EMAIL ADDRESS?

The credit union acknowledges that members may change email service providers from time to time and therefore have to change their email address. Please make sure your email address is up to date with the credit union. It is your responsibility to monitor and maintain your contact information. If you feel you are not receiving email notifications from us, please contact the credit union. Occasionally, internet providers may blacklist or block certain emails which is outside of the credit union's control.

WHAT IF I NO LONGER WANT TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS PROGRAM?

If you find that you are no longer interested in this service you can easily remove yourself from it by choosing the "Cancel e-Mail" button within the "Access Accounts - e-Mail Notification" section of Net Access or by contacting the credit union.
